- Reported that the City has completed the remodel of the Williams ambulance quarters. Updated on status of Ambulance study being conducted by AP Triton. The draft study should be completed in July.
- Reported that the Request for Proposals is out for the future station Phase 1 work.

Copies of the 2021-2022 Fire Suppression and Protection Services Assessment Engineer's Report, prepared by SCI Consulting Group was distributed to each board member.

Robert Mendoza moved to accept the Audit Report for the year ended 6/30/2020, as presented by Perry, Bumch and Johnston, Inc. CPA's. Motion was 2^{nd} by Allen Gobel. Motion passed.
